

My speech today includes several titles topped by the state law. Actions witnessed recently in the last few days show that no one is above law whatever his position is and this is a new start towards our aim "development", because development can not be witnessed where injustice or corruption exists. In this concern also our great justice issued a decree dissolving the National Democratic Party and regaining the state-owned assets. This issue was discussed in the last cabinet meeting and we decided to wait for the justice decree to determine means of benefiting from NDP's buildings and we agreed to allocate one of them the National Council for Human Rights and the other to the Specialized National Councils. Allocation of these two buildings to these specific councils is a symbolic message showing that these buildings will be used in human rights, science and studies. When talking about state law we need to move forward towards society where the immunity of the citizen will be his interest protected by law.

The second point is security. There is gradual improvement in the security level in streets, and we still have large effort in such field. I assert that "police to serve people" is the slogan and same time law and people protect police. It is our duty to provide protection and assistance to police to face bullying.

From another side, a huge governors' change has taken and we work to speed security in localities, and I repeat it security then security is our aim. Within the decree of the dissolving NDP, quick legislations will be issued concerning

councils and means to deal with them over the coming period.

The next point is democracy and democracy in its simple definition means people's right to draw future including future of the country, his family and sons. Participation in the country's future through the political participation is the main point.

The Legislative Committee in the cabinet, headed by the Vice Prime Minister, carried studies on draft law concerning practicing of political rights. This suggestion will be presented to you as soon as possible aiming to let most people participate in the political process, and to guarantee the right of people who lives abroad to vote as well. These legislations will be presented to you before approval to be able expressing your opinions. Regarding participation, I am convinced that selection of leaders to participate such as the university leaders shall be taken through taking opinions of the teaching staff and the Minister of Higher Education is already working in this.

I call the teaching staff and students in all universities to continue the current study year so that their efforts will not be gone in vain, and afterwards there will be a new frame for selection through sound and democratic ways.

The last week I met group of farmers, and I really benefited from meeting them and we agreed on the necessity of strengthening the entity that represent farmers. We are

interested in agriculture over the coming phase, and in cooperation with other colleagues we discuss means of establishing a syndicate for farmers or strengthening the general federation of farmers to be the entity we can talk with and farmers can participate as well to draw the agriculture future in Egypt.

Under the umbrella of democracy and through polls taken, we found that most people are not convinced with the summer timing and in this concern we will present a suggestion to the coming cabinet meeting for canceling the summer timing.

The last point is prices, You have to be sure that we feel what people suffer from prices increase of some commodities and in accordance to this we decided to allocate additional EGP ١٠ billion to support supplies and provide main goods with lower prices includes gas pipes. Upon crisis witnessed in gas pipes, the Minister of Social Solidarity and Justice held several meetings with the Minister of Petroleum and the situation is better now but information we received states that some gas pipes storages and lorries are attacked. In this concern, I would like asserting that bullying will be strictly punished because we don't accept attack on the right of people or country.

Regarding the production issue, I think you are no sure we fulfill what we promise but we may differ in timing. Indicators show that production is better than before but you must know that the continuity of the revolution and achieving its aims related to production increase not only to

reach previous levels but to increase it because we face more challenges than before and time nowadays call for the necessity of increasing production. In this concern, I speak about people's demands which decreased from 18 demonstrations daily to 2 and I work to achieve all demands. People's demands are right and it divided into two parts; one part we can deal with as being special demands and other are general one such as salaries. The Minister of Finance announced that during May there will be a new salaries restructuring.

I repeat my call to people to work hard to regain our gross losses and I thank writers in newspapers and TV shows that call for the necessity of production. I called the Central Bank of Egypt to set a quick plan to finance and provide facilities required for stumbled factories.

I would like to say that Egypt's image before enemies and friends need more effort and production because our friends look to Egypt a leader country and we need to regain our strength, and our enemies wish Egypt not to be leader country and this need more effort and production to prove our leadership. The right to disagree is legal but the way of expressing must be through dialogue and not leading to harm others like traffic stoppage because in this traffic there may be a patient who need to go to hospital, or mother or father need to go to their sons.

The last point I always say is let's go to Egypt, Egypt here means production, solidarity, sacrifice and patience Egypt. All these call for more production, solidarity and sacrifice

feelings which we witnessed in Al-Tahrir square. Finally I wish to say I am optimistic and Egypt's future will be excellent where the whole world watch us. Long live Egypt and long live our noble revolution.
